All families and friends are welcome do come along and participate in any of the activities listed above.

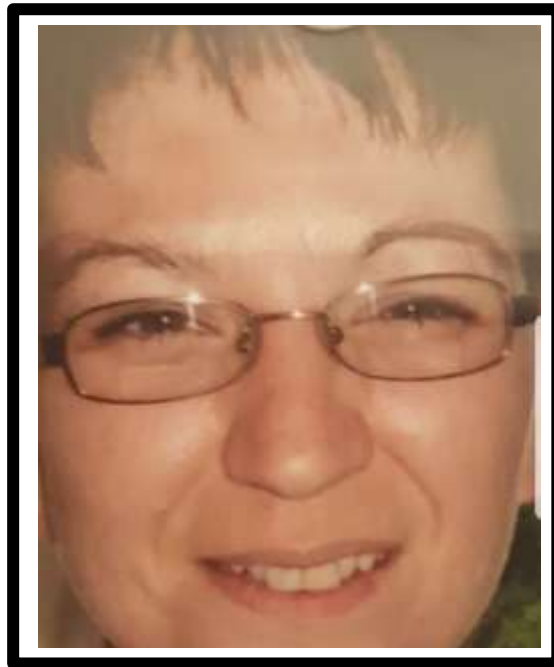
If you wish to have dinner /tea with your loved one please let us know a day before so we can accommodate a meal for you.
