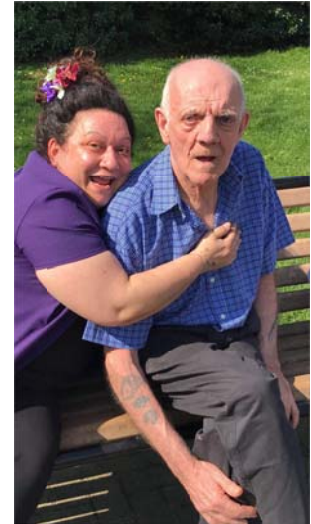
How long has Kerri been at Park View?
