“Employee of the Month”

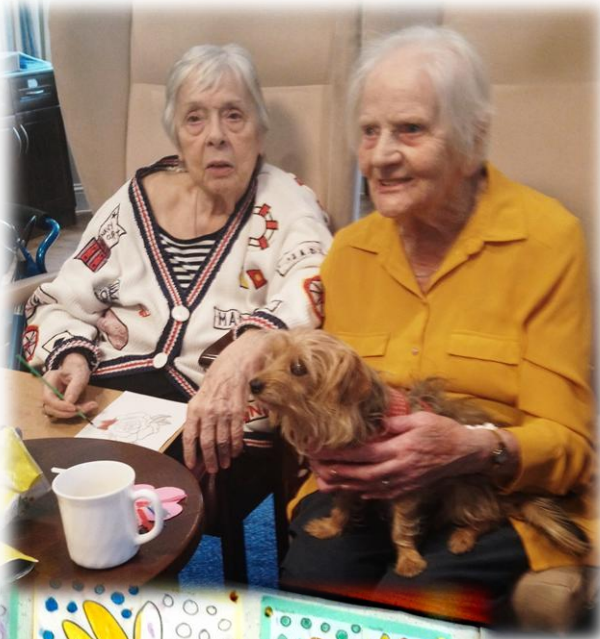
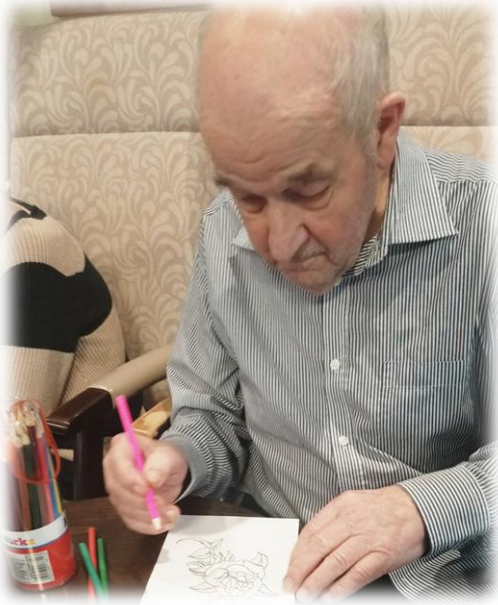


Congratulations to Kelly and Charlie who have received Employee of the Month. (No Photo of Charlie)
