# BIRTHDAY CELEBRATIONS!!!

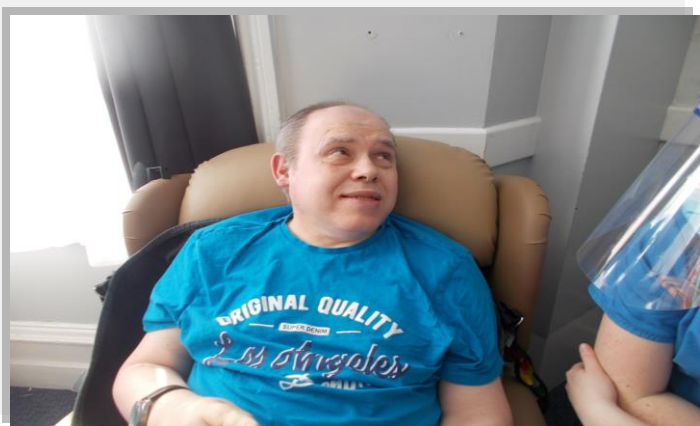
Caroline celebrated her birthday, with a lovely surprise from her sister who made Caroline's birthday cake. Safe to say everyone enjoyed it very much!
