
MID KENT COLLEGE DONATED A CARE PACKAGE TO OUR

FEEL FREE TO SIT OUT IN THE GARDEN WHEN YOU VISIT.






































RESIDENT OF THE MONTH INTRODUCING TREVOR

HE WAS CHIEF FOR OVER 10 YEARS FOLLOWED BY A


2ND ASSISTANT MEDICAL STAFF. WHEN HE LEFT THE
