
## Employees of the month


We celebrated Remembrance Day by making & decorating poppies, residents watched the remembrance parade on the T.V with such pride.

Hillbeck held a culture day during November. We enjoyed an afternoon of bright and colourful traditional clothing


modelled by our amazing staff. Our favourite part was the dancing which residents just had to join in!
