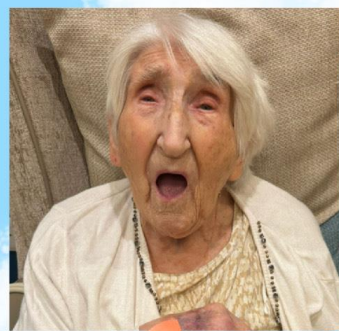

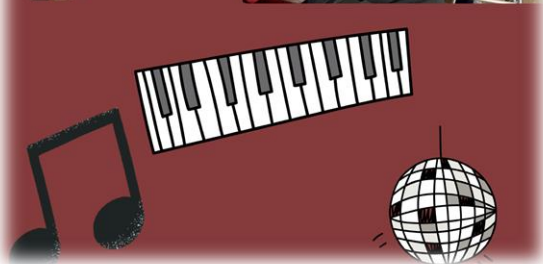

6th Dec – Christmas Fair from 2.00 pm

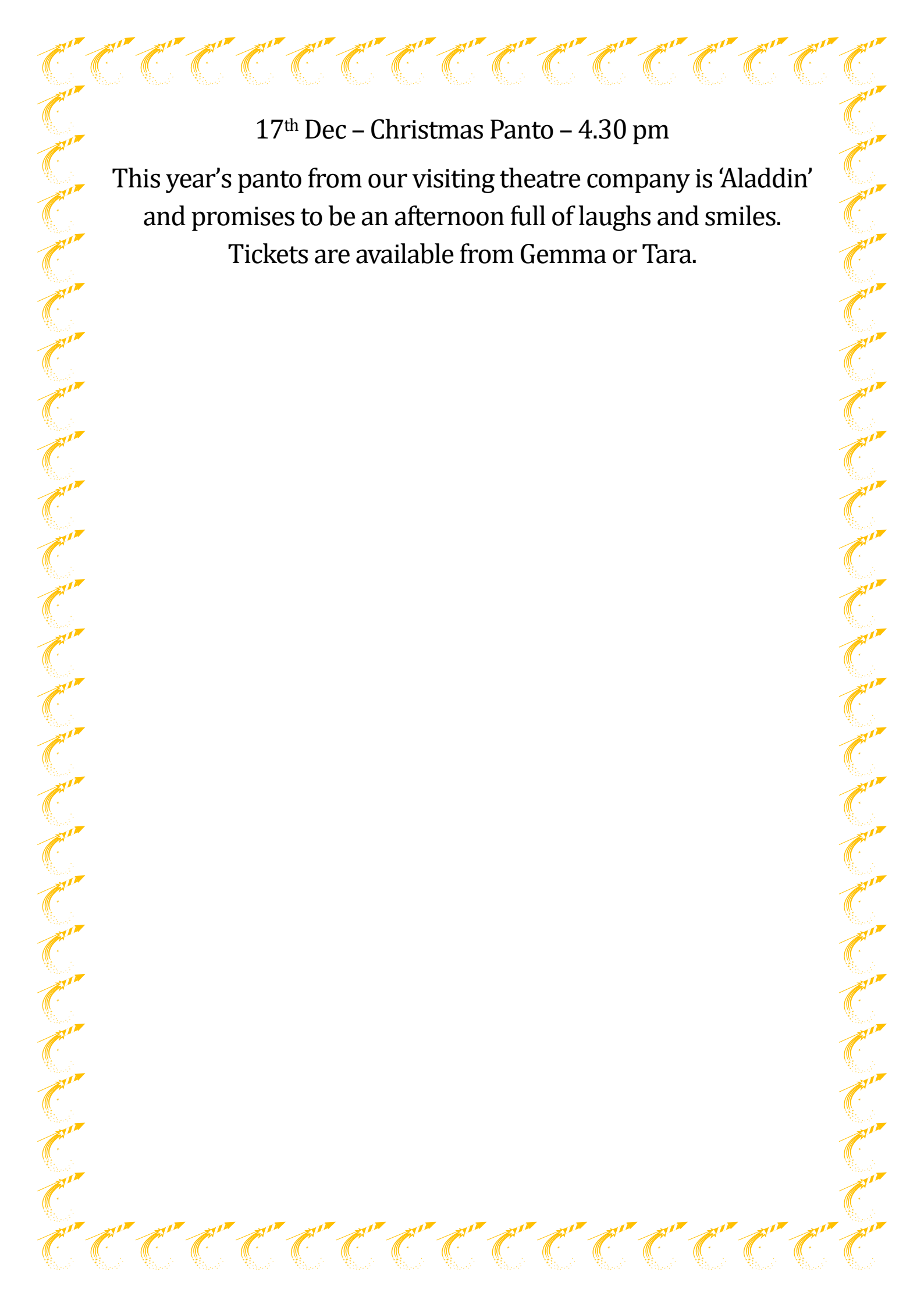

15th Dec – Christmas Meal

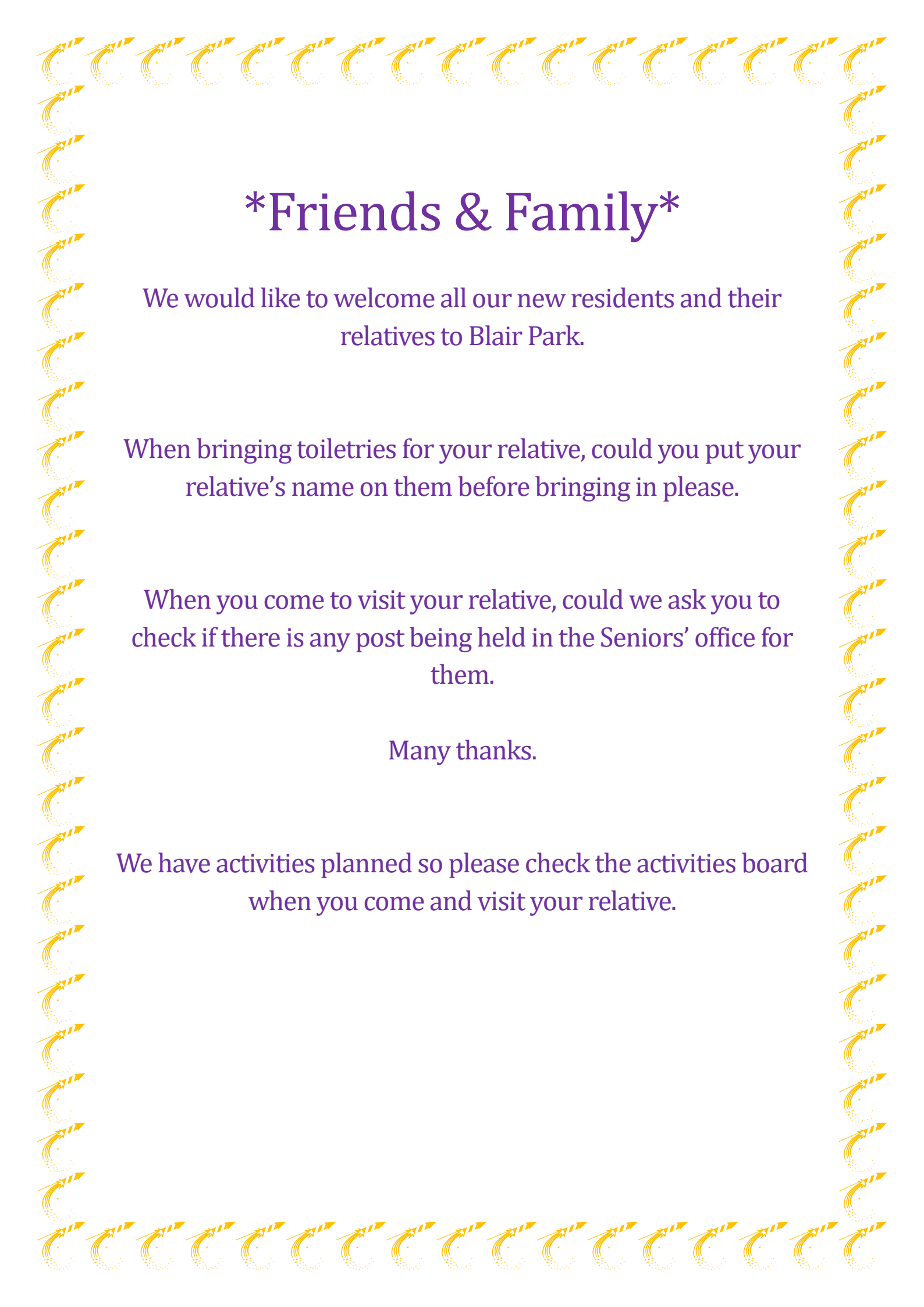

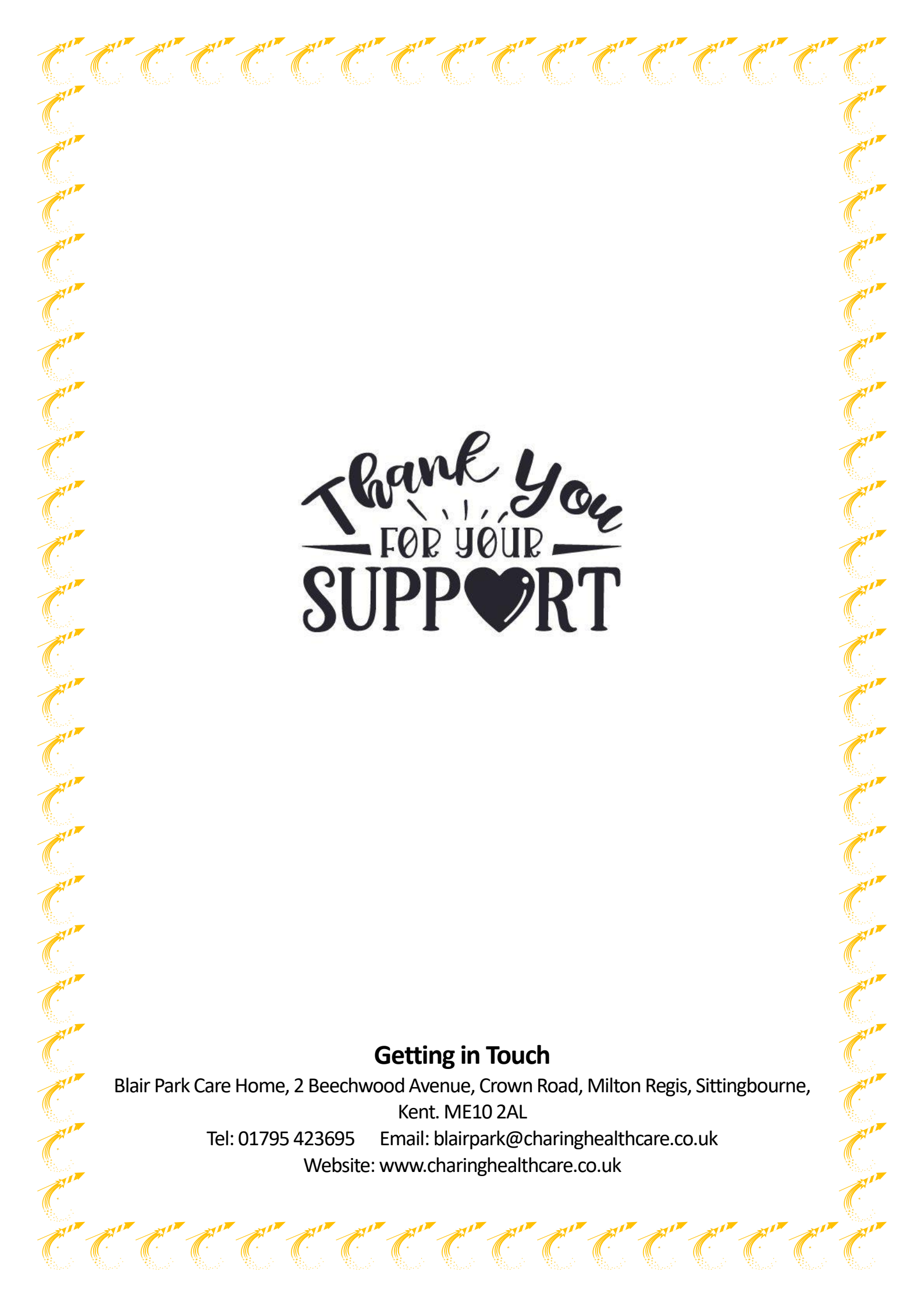
We would like to welcome all our new residents and their relatives to Blair Park.
