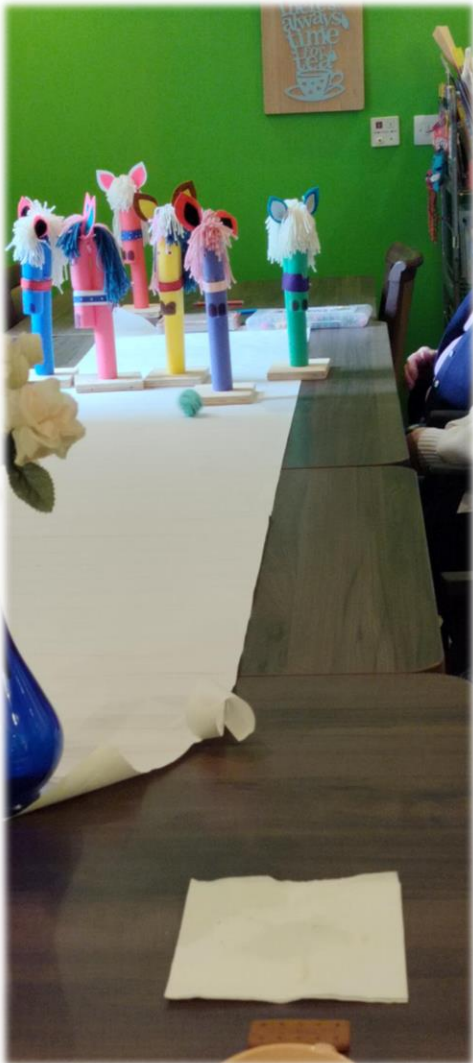




































Marion & Rosa's Round Up
