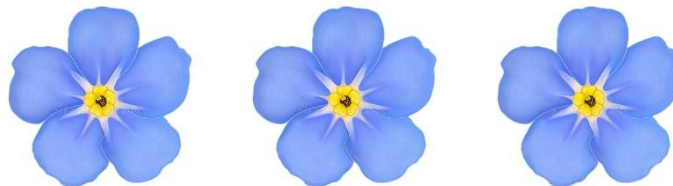


Hillbeck Newsletter

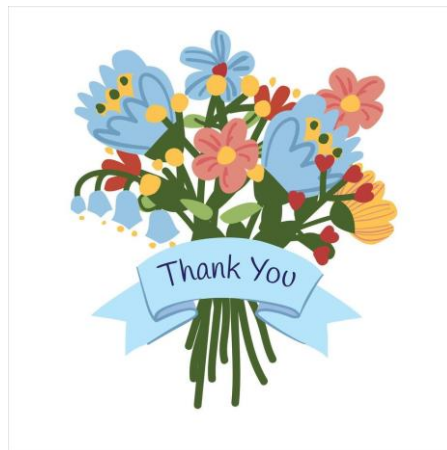
